Wedding Ceremonies at Pastures Lodge & Best Western Pastures Hotel

Pastures Lodge holds a civil wedding ceremony license. Our license allows you to hold your Civil Marriage Ceremony in either The Stuart Suite or The Castle Suite and continue your afternoon and evening celebrations.

Civil Wedding Ceremony £275

The charge for the hire of our approved Civil Wedding Rooms is £275.00. This fee is non-refundable and must be paid at the time of booking of the Civil Marriage Ceremony.

We are happy to discuss your requirements or queries in relation to the Civil Marriage Ceremony, and show you the designated room at a suitable time, or by prior appointment.

Our Wedding Co-ordinator will be happy to advise you in the planning of your special day.

Do not make any formal arrangements such as printing invitations, hiring cars/photographers etc. unless you have contacted the Superintendent Registrar and have received confirmation that registration staff will be available to attend

Pastures Lodge for the ceremony on the day and time of your choice.

Civil Marriages can legally take place seven days a week, again, subject to availability of the Superintendent Registrar and his staff.

Renewal of Vows Ceremonies £275

The Ceremony is for any married couple who wish to renew their commitment to one another in a special way. A wonderful way to celebrate a special anniversary. Renewal of Vows Ceremonies are available from 1pm to 5pm on a Saturday and from 10am to 5pm on a Sunday.

Civil Naming Ceremonies £150

Civil Naming Ceremonies, a non religious alternative to church christenings. Civil Naming Ceremonies are only available 1pm to 5pm on a Saturday and from 10am to 5pm on a Sunday.

Booking Your Civil Marriage

We hope your marriage will be a happy and memorable occasion and the following information is given as a guide to help you with your arrangements.

- It is the bride and the bridegrooms responsibility to contact the Register Office at Doncaster to check the Registrar is available on the chosen date at Pastures Lodge.
- The Register Office is situated at Elmfield Park, South Parade, Doncaster. Telephone (01302) 364922.
- The Register Office will advise you of a date for the notice of marriage, which means a visit to the Register Office situated in the district(s) in which you reside, i.e. Doncaster or Rotherham, to give the notice of marriage. A notice of marriage is valid for twelve months. It is necessary to make an appointment at Rotherham Register Office, if this is the district in which you live.
- Rotherham Register Office is situated at Bailey House, Rawmarsh Road, Rotherham. Telephone (01709) 823542.

When you visit the Register Office to give notice of marriage you will need to:

1. provide the necessary documents
2. pay the appropriate fee.

You will have to make a further visit to the Doncaster Register Office to pay the attendance fees for the Superintendent Registrar and Registrar, and to discuss the format of your ceremony.

A ceremony of marriage conducted by a Superintendent Registrar at an approved premises cannot, by law, contain any religious aspects.

Rights of copyright for music, readings etc. permitted at the ceremony are a matter for the couple.

Please note your marriage cannot go ahead unless legal formalities have been completed.



The Ceremony

Prior to the ceremony, the Registrar will take the Groom into a separate room from the guests to check all the required details.

- The ceremony must be held in the designated room, The Stuart Suite or The Castle Suite.
- No food or drink can be served prior to or during the ceremony in the designated room.
- The designated room can be tastefully decorated with flowers.
- There must be no religious artifacts decorating the room.
- The Bride can proceed through the room accompanied by the appropriate music, this must be non-religious.

A reading of poetry or passages from a favourite book can be made by anyone in the gathered party, but they must not have any religious overtones.

A religious blessing can be performed for the Bride and Groom at the end of the ceremony, this of course must be arranged by the Bride and Groom at the discretion of their own church or ministry. Pastures Lodge must be also notified by the Bride and Groom if a blessing is to take place.

Pastures Lodge, have available for your use a CD player for your wedding music.

A limited choice of wedding music is available for your use, but you also may bring your own CD's. Pastures Lodge staff are not responsible for the choice of your music.

You must discuss your choice of music with Pastures Lodge at least one week before the ceremony is due to take place. This will help ensure that the correct music is played on the day.

The Stuart Suite is an attractive room, tastefully decorated with private bar, toilet and cloakroom facilities.

Best Western Pastures Hotel

The bride & groom can relax and enjoy their evening in our excellently furnished bridal suite. The Fitzwilliam Suite offers an en-suite bathroom with jacuzzi, and four poster bed.

Our executive room, The Rockingham Suite is also an excellent choice and offers a walk in shower, TV in bathroom and is decorated to an excellently high standard.

Should your guests require overnight accommodation, they too can enjoy the comfort and luxury of one of our 58 rooms at the rate of £70 per double room including full English or Continental breakfast.

All bedrooms are non smoking with ensuite facilities and are tastefully decorated to a high standard, including hairdryer, satellite LCD TV, direct dial telephone and complimentary WIFI and wired internet access. Car parking is available with night security and CCTV.

Accommodation will be available from 2:00pm on the day of arrival and should be vacated by 11:00am on the day of departure.

Booking Conditions: A provisional booking can be held for 14 days, when a NON-REFUNDABLE deposit of £500 will be required to confirm your booking. If a deposit has not been paid after 14 days, the date may then be released by Pastures Lodge.

Cancellation: In the event of a cancellation of a booking by the customer, the customer may be required to pay a cancellation fee. However, Pastures Lodge will do its utmost to re-let the Stuart Suite and if successful, only the deposit shall be forfeited, if, having used their best endeavours we are unable to do so, the customer will then be liable to incur a cancellation charge. Wedding Receptions cancelled over three months prior to the Reception, will incur 50% charge of the total account. Wedding Receptions cancelled under three months will incur 75% charge of the total account.

Minimum Numbers: The minimum number of guests during the months of May, June, July and August for a wedding breakfast is 70 during the day on a Saturday. On all other days the minimum number of guests to cater for is 50 during the day.

Children: Children under two are free of charge and are not taken into consideration in the calculation of cancellation charges. Children between the ages of two and ten years will be charged at half-price and will be taken into account in the calculation of cancellation charges.

Payment Terms: 90% of the total charges for the inclusive package one month prior to the event and the balance is required 14 days prior to the date of the function.

Final Numbers: The exact number of guests should be advised 1 week before the event, and unless more people are catered for on the day this will be the number for which you will be charged.

Evening Buffet: If no evening buffet is required following a wedding breakfast then there will be a room hire charge of £500. We do not permit refreshments or discos to be provided by any party other than Pastures Lodge. Prices shown in this package are correct at the time of printing but may be subject to alteration.

Best Western Pastures Hotel: Alcoholic Drinks purchased at Pastures Lodge must not be consumed in Best Western Pastures Hotel, at any time. It is advisable to arrange adequate insurance cover as the hotel will not be held responsible for any loss or damage caused to the client's property, including wedding gifts brought into the hotel.

Buffets: All buffets must cater for at least 90% of your guests to ensure that the quantity of food is balanced & gives you peace of mind.

Insurance: Pastures Leisure Ltd strongly recommend that you take out wedding insurance with an independant company.

Fireworks: Unfortunately firework displays are not allowed at the Lodge or Hotel or anywhere else in the surrounding grounds. Also Confetti cannons, exploding balloons and metallic confetti may not be used under any circumstances.
